## **Landowner Participation Agreement**

The Coast Ridge Community Forest (CRCF) is proposing a Fire Prevention Project for CAL FIRE grant funding.

Project Summary: The purpose of the Coast Ridge Community Forest Fire Prevention Project is to protect life, property, and the environment by reducing hazardous fuels and improving forest health. Listed as High Priority in the Fort Ross CWPP, the project will create shaded fuel breaks along 20 miles of public and private roads in the communities of Blue Jay, Sea View Ranch, Gualala Ranch, and Navarro Ranch. The fuel breaks will vary in width from 30 to 50 feet edge of road, dependent on vegetation and topography. When completed they will become part of a shaded fuel break network including Muniz Ranches and Jenner Headlands Preserve.

If grant funding is awarded, the CRCF agrees to provide a list of services that will be conducted on my property before any work begins. These services will be performed in a way to ensure the sustainability of the forest resource such that current management options will continue to be possible in the future.

By agreeing to voluntarily participate in the CRCF Fire Prevention Project I understand that this would be a long-term commitment and I am willing to participate in community maintenance as needed.
